

LIVING IN TIANJIN

Tianjin, one of China's four municipalities, is located 50KM inland from the Bohai Gulf and is a 30 minute high-speed train ride from Beijing. Tianjin spans China's largest artificial harbour and is a key trade and transportation hub serving northern China. Tianjin has been nicknamed "The Shanghai of the North" in reference to its history as a foreign concession, and its large port in Tanggu. The city is very modern, but also has many temples of various religious affiliations and is itself a museum of late 19th century European architecture.
